WBMS Parents and Guardians,

This letter is notice regarding information about several policies and procedures regarding our school cafeteria.

We offer a full service cafeteria, providing our students access to both breakfast and lunch meals. Should your student choose to purchase breakfast at school, the price of the meal is \$1.05. Should your student choose to purchase lunch at school, the price of the meal is \$2.75. Both are optional, as students may eat breakfast at home and/or bring their own lunch to school.

To add money to your student's meal account, you may do so directly through our cafeteria or through the My School Bucks website (<https://www.myschoolbucks.com/ver2/login/getmain?requestAction=home>). You can also monitor your student's meal balance through the My School Bucks website.

Free and reduced price meals are also available to students who qualify. The income eligibility guidelines for free or reduced price meals shall be in accordance with the scales provided by the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer services.

The Free/Reduced online application, which is one method of applying for free or reduced breakfast and lunch benefits, is available at <https://www.myschoolapps.com/>.

Additionally, a paper copy of the application is available and may be submitted at the school office.

Finally, please be aware that it is school board policy that meals may not be charged. Should a student not have a meal, either they do not have meal money or did not bring a meal from home, they will be referred to administration. At that time, administration will work with the student to make arrangements for food/a meal.
