

**NOTICE OF NEW EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES IMPACT FEES
For All Unincorporated and Incorporated Areas of Santa Rosa County, Florida**

At the January 9, 2020 meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Rosa County, Florida, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 2020-01, which establishes and levies educational facilities impact fees to fund capital improvements and additions to the Santa Rosa County public schools needed to serve new growth. These new impact fees are imposed on all residential construction that applies for a building permit on or after the close of business day on May 1, 2020, occurring within the unincorporated area of the County and within the municipal limits of Gulf Breeze, Jay, and Milton. The impact fees will be due and collected at the issuance of a building permit at the following rates:

Educational Facilities Impact Fee Schedule

<u>Land Use Type</u>	<u>Impact Fee Per Unit</u>
Single Family	\$5,000
Mobile Home	\$4,000
Multi-Family	\$2,750
